## Yard Clean Up



## Winter Prep

Let's prepare! Now is the time to start checking your heat tape, furnace and skirting to make ensure that you and your pipes will stay toasty this winter.

Make sure to check that your home's heat tape and heat wand are plugged in and working. It should be warm to the touch, similar to the temperature of warm toast.

Make sure that all outside hoses are disconnected from your outside spigot. This is VERY IMPORTANT. If your hose is not disconnected, and it freezes, it could cause a large amount of damage to your home.

It is also necessary during the upcoming cold winter months that you pay careful attention to your skirting. The skirting on your home helps to block the wind and cold temperatures, which helps to protect your pipes. Taking a few moments now can save you trouble later.
